Talking Points:

<u>Diligence is Fundamental</u>: Without diligence, we cannot strive for excellence. Mediocrity is the normal existence for those who fail to strive for excellence, and our lives (as well as the lives of those around us) are less fulfilled as a result.

<u>Diligence requires Commitment</u>: Diligence, by nature, is a long term commitment do doing our very best at all that we put our hands to do. Scripture reminds us that whatever our hands find to do, we do it as unto the Lord, putting forth our very best effort.

<u>Diligence requires Integrity</u>: Putting forth our best effort requires honesty, as ultimately only we know if we are doing our very best or not. When diligence is blended with integrity, the end result is excellence in effort and accomplishment.

<u>Diligence promotes Success</u>: People who are diligent achieve great things in life. Success cannot be garnered without diligence, and those who give 110% of themselves will achieve things in life most people can only dream about. Mediocrity (good enough) is the enemy of excellence, and there are few people who strive to make excellence a daily part of their lives.
